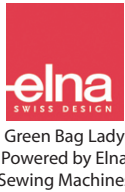


# Green Bag Lady Tiny Bag Ornament Pattern

## Step 1

Cut 2--3.5" x 3.5" squares of wool felt

Place a ruler at the left edge of bag, make marks at 1.25" and 2.25" this is the CENTER of where to attach handles



Cut a 5/8 inch square out of the bottom corners on both sides

## Step 2

Cut 2 strips of wool felt 1/2" x 4" for the handles

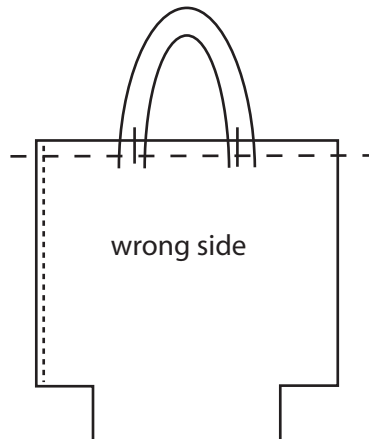


## Step 3

- make any decorations for the front and back of the bag that you wish, I put an initial on the front and who it was from on the back
- machine or handstich the initial to the bag, I used 3 strands of embroidery thread for the hand stitching
- cut out letters freehand or enlarge a font on the computer to use as a template
- if you have a letter font on your sewing machine, this is a great way to make a tag for the back
- sew these on BEFORE you sew the front and the back of the bag together!

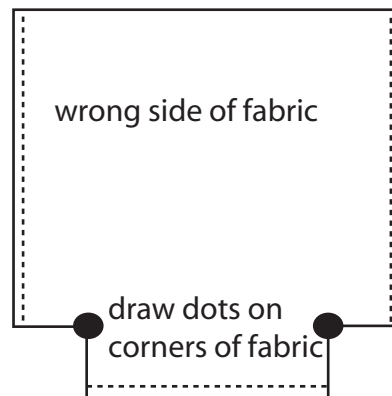
## Step 4

Sew only left side of the front and back together, then attach the handles, use a decorative stitch if you like



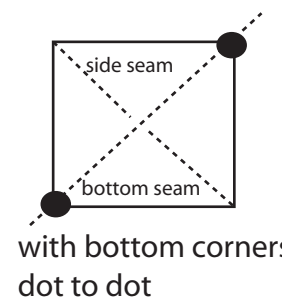
## Step 5

After you have the handles on, sew the other side, bottom & corners 1/8 in from edge, turn bag right side out



•Helpful hint: pinch dots in both hands and pull so fabric is flat and looks like diagram below

## Step 6

- cut 4 pieces of cardboard 1" x 3" for the inside of the bolts of fabric
- cut 4 pieces of fabric 3.5" x 6" for the fabric on the bolts
- fold the top edge of the fabric down 1/2 in and roll the rest of it around the cardboard, secure with a straight pin
- tuck tiny bolts in your completed tiny bag-enjoy!
